Starting with the 2016 show season, SOCA will award \$500 to the high point youth rider at the Obstacle Challenges and \$500 to the high point youth rider at the Extreme Cowboy Races.

The youth/horse combination must compete in all 2017 SOCA Obstacle Challenges to be eligible for the \$500 Challenge Fund Award.

The youth/horse combination must compete in all 2017 SOCA Extreme Cowboy Races to be eligible for the \$500 Race Fund Award.

The Youth must be a paid member of SOCA for the 2017 season. The same youth can win both awards if they attend all races and challenges.



# REMINDER: CHANGES FOR 2017 OBSTACLE CHALLENGES

- <u>Divisions for 2017</u> Youth, Posse, Novice Horse & Rider, Intermediate Horse & Rider (currently called Non Pro), Open/Elite & Training
- Riders will be required to move up to the next division if they place in the top 3 at least 3 times in that division, except Youth. This is <u>cumulative</u>!
- Training division is judged, but not scored – You will get a card for the judges to give a score, but they won't be tabulated or prizes given. Simply training.

#### NOTICE

The below notes were sent to all SOCA judges in preparation for the coming show season. We are publishing to our members so you know what judges have been instructed to do and look for.

## **NOTES FOR JUDGES – OBSTACLE CHALLENGES**

- Once an obstacle has been engaged, rider may not start over, only proceed from where horse left obstacle. If horse balks and refuses in the obstacle, rider may not choose to start over. Horse must always show forward motion.
- Once an obstacle is completed or 60 seconds has been called to move on, rider must move on to next obstacle, EVEN IF there is no one waiting for the obstacle. No schooling or training can be allowed.
   Judging requires concentration and it is unfair to our judges to have to be aware of the horse's presence if the horse becomes unruly. Even a short moment of relaxation helps the judges be prepared for the next rider.
- Completing the obstacle is not enough anymore. Our riders have all improved. Judges need to be
  watching for horsemanship skills. Quiet hands, using leg and seat aids quietly, no clucking or other aids.
  Use of reins or crop to move horse forward should be penalized. Use of reins or aids to punish horse
  should be penalized heavily.
- It is the rider's responsibility to read the course and obstacle instructions. Specific questions are welcome, but judges are not there to explain every obstacle to every rider. If a rider asks questions, directions should be given before rider performing obstacle and not repeated once rider has engaged obstacle. Be sure your instructions are clear and understood and if rider makes a mistake, do not instruct until obstacle is complete and scored.
- Each obstacle is allowed 60 seconds to complete. Riders must stop attempting obstacle, retrieve score sheets and move on when instructed by judge. Any violation of this will be considered disrespect of SOCA judges and will be given a score of 0.
- We ask that riders who want to ride in groups, please be aware if an obstacle bunches up and break up
  your groups to proceed to the next obstacle and move along alone or in smaller groups.
- All riders should approach the judge with scoresheets and not wait for the judge to come to you. That's
  a lot of steps in a day. Please be respectful of judges and help them do their jobs when possible.
- Please do not ask to see your scoresheet or attempt to take a photo. It takes time from the judge and riders behind you. Scoresheets are available after the awards ceremonies.
- There should be a penalty for horses being out of frame, head tossing or any signs of distress when stopping.
- Even if a horse performs an obstacle, there should be a penalty if horse cannot stand still at any time
  during the obstacle, when appropriate. "Hot feet" means that a horse is nervous about the task. SOCA
  rewards a calm, willing attitude.

## **2017 High Points**

In 2017 SOCA will award high point <u>obstacle challenge</u> winners in the following divisions:
Novice, Youth, Intermediate, Open Elite and Posse. Points from each of the 2017 SOCA Obstacle Challenges will be totaled and the horse/rider team with the most points will be the high point champion. Based on the feedback from members, the high point award will be custom SOCA buckles. Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place for high point.

Regional Championship buckles for the Extreme Cowboy Races will be determined by points accumulated at SOCA events only. The horse/rider teams accumulating the most points at each designated SOCA EXCA race (with the triple points at the Nationals in June and Regional Championship races in September and double points for all State Championships) will be awarded the high point buckle in the following divisions: Pro, Non-Pro, Ride Smart, Novice, Intermediate, Youth and Young Guns.

To be eligible for high point buckles, SOCA members must have attended all challenges or races.
