How Often Should You Bathe Your Horse?

How frequently you bathe your horse depends on preference. Once a week is probably too often—you don't want to strip your horse's skin of the essential natural oils it produces to make their coat shiny and beautiful. Once a year, on the other hand, is far too infrequent. Not only can your horse's mane become tangled, but it's also important to clean your horse's hooves to prevent potential hoof ailments or even worse, an infection. When giving your horse a bath, it's always recommended to follow horse hoof cleaning techniques to maintain their health and well-being.



Evaluate how dirty your horse is by asking yourself a few questions:

- Is your horse itchy or uncomfortable?
- Do they seem extra sweaty and dusty?
- Did they roll in wet grass and mud recently?
- Did they roll in some other unidentified substance?
- Is it the end of spring, when their winter coat is likely shedding?
- Is your horse's mane and tail begging for some detangling love?

If you answered yes to any of these questions, bust out the bucket and brushes. It's time for a scrub down.

2021 High Points

In 2021 SOCA will award high point <u>obstacle challenge</u> winners in the following divisions: Novice, Youth, Intermediate and Open Elite. Points from both of the 2021 SOCA Obstacle Challenges will be totaled and the horse/rider team with the most points will be the high point champion. Please make sure you see the "moving up" rules on the event flyers.

Regional Championship buckles for the Extreme Cowboy Races will be determined by points accumulated at SOCA events only. The horse/rider teams accumulating the most points at each designated SOCA EXCA race (with 5 times points at the Nationals and triple points at the Regional Championship races, as well as double points for all State Championships) will be awarded the high point buckle in the following divisions: Pro, Non-Pro, Ride Smart, Novice, Green Horse, Intermediate, Youth and Young Guns. Buckles can only be awarded to those that attend all races or obstacle challenges.

SOCA dues (\$10) are due January Ist!
Please renew at your first event of the year. Dues help fund the highpoint awards and administrative costs of the club.
