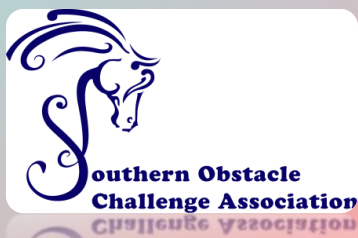
### First Event of 2015

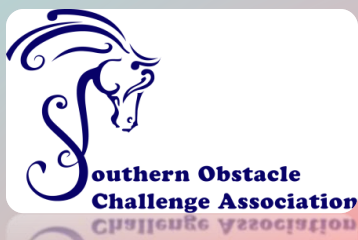

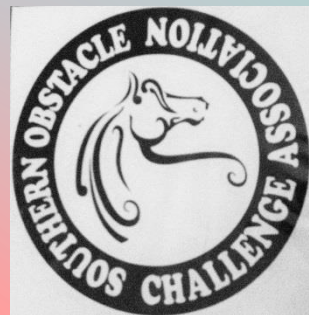

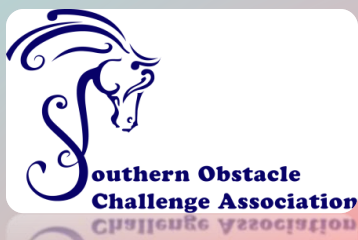

## What is the EXCA?

**If you want to learn more, come to one of the clinics (12/27/14 or 1/10/15)**

We have had a number of questions about Extreme Cowboy Racing, so we thought it beneficial to provide this information about the EXCA. The EXCA is the original and only recognized association for the sport of Extreme Cowboy Racing. The Extreme Cowboy Race™ was originated by the first "Original Extreme Cowboy", Craig Cameron. Extreme Cowboy Racing combines horsemanship with speed. The event is judged, as well as timed. Horse and rider teams must execute a series of obstacles that represent trail or ranch work, while demonstrating horsemanship with speed. Obstacles may include water crossing, shooting, roping, negotiating trash or dead fall, ground tying, jumping, dragging and always includes the signature free ride. Horses must be able to run wide open and then rein back to perform slow, technical maneuvers or obstacles. Horses can be of any breed, age, size and sex. The cowboys and cowgirls range in age from 8 to 80!

**How Extreme is the event?** Extreme is part of the original name used for the first televised event. The word, "Extreme" also acknowledges that our event is directly associated with Craig Cameron who originated the sport as we know it and is founder of the Extreme Cowboy Association. The vast majority of the obstacles that you will encounter in a sanctioned EXCA event are things you will routinely encounter while on a trail ride or daily work on a ranch.

**Does my horse need to have specialized training?** No. Horses of all breeds with little or no specialized training are encouraged to participate. Two of the primary purposes of the sport are to have fun with your horse and improve your horsemanship at the same time.

**Are there clothing or tack requirements?** Western style clothing and tack are required.

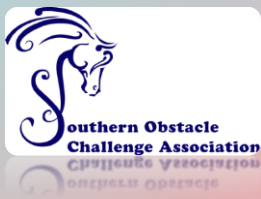
**Are all Extreme Cowboy Association courses the same?** No, the courses will be different at every event. The obstacles, terrain and length of the courses will vary.

**What about scoring?** A score is given for each obstacle on the course. A score is also given for overall horsemanship and speed. Each obstacle consist of 3 components: the Approach to the obstacle, the Obstacle itself and the Departure from the obstacle.

**What are the division?** Young Guns (11 & Under), Youth, Novice, Intermediate, Non Pro, Ride Smart (55 & Over), Pro and Green Horse.

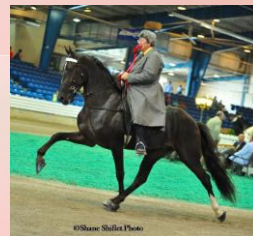

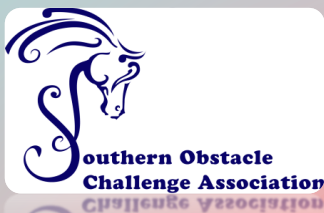

## 2015 High Points

In 2015 SOCA will award high point obstacle challenge winners in the following divisions: Novice, Youth, Non Pro, Open Elite and Posse. Points from each of the 2015 SOCA Obstacle Challenges will be totaled, with double points at the obstacle challenge championship in November. The horse/rider team with the most points will be the high point champion. Based on the feedback from members, the high point award will be custom SOCA buckles.

Regional Championship buckles for the Extreme Cowboy Races will be determined by points accumulated at SOCA events only. The horse/rider teams accumulating the most points at each designated SOCA EXCA race, with the triple points at the Nationals in June and Regional Championship races in September and double points for State Championships in January, April and June, will be awarded the high point buckle in the following divisions: Pro, Non-Pro, Ride Smart, Novice, Intermediate, Youth, and Non-Pro.

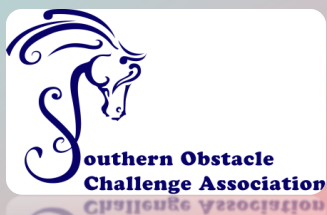

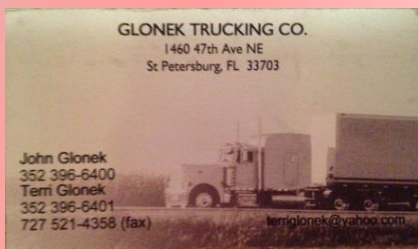
